School Affairs

Liverpool Central School is offering a 4 year old expanded pre-K program for the 2020-2021 school year. Your child must turn 4 between Dec. 2, 2019 and Dec. 1, 2020, to be eligible. Applications should be filed by March 15 to be considered for the initial selection process. The LCSD website has the application and more information about the program.
