The Town of Clay Brush Collection began on March 17 and will continue every Tuesday until December 8. Biodegradable lawn bags are acceptable, if kept dry and intact. Place all containers outside of road pavement and gutters so as not to obstruct traffic or block drainiage. Looking Back into Bayberry History

1956 Bayberry Wins Award for Housing Progress

CLAY – One of the building industry's most coveted prizes, the House & Home Magazine 1956 award of merit, has been given to the builders of Bayberry Communities "in recognition of their outstanding contribution to housing progress."

Bayberry Properties, Inc. is slated to begin construction this spring of 1,200 homes, a shopping center, sewage treatment plant, three swimming pools and its own sewage and water system on several hundred acres it owns in the town of Clay.

Announcement of the award was made by Perry I. Prentice, editor and publisher of House & Home Magazine. The award, for residential design and construction, was made at the convention of the National Assn. of Home Builders in Chicago last week.

The magazine cited the Bayberry "House for Family Living" in its survey of homes that are setting "a new standard of design and a new standard of living ability far above anything previously available to the average family."

The acclamation of Bayberry planning and design follows closely after a recent eight-page full color article in the Woman's Home Companion. Other recent awards presented to Bayberry include the Mayfair magazine "House of the Year" presentation, as well as citations in other national publications.

C. Ellis Schiffmacher, board chairman of Bayberry, says that "the planning of the Bayberry community in the Syracuse area indicates it will be the most beautiful community we have ever built. I know that when we begin our homes there this spring they will achieve both national and local acclaim for value and imagination."
