## TOWN AFFAIRS

The demolition of the former Pizzeria Uno restaurant has started for the development of the Chick-fil-A at 4000 State Route 31.

The new IHOP restaurant construction is well underway in front of Great Northern Mall and we will keep you updated via social media when an opening date is announced.

A petition is being filed with the Town of Clay requesting two stop signs to be placed at the intersection of Cherry Tree Circle and Blackberry Road where the walkway exits the green area behind the Oriole/Quail loop. Over 100 residents and former residents signed the petition to help residents crossing safely across Blackberry Road to Cherry Tree Circle.

There have been many complaints regarding feral cats in Bayberry and the Town of Clay by residents. This matter was brought to the attention of the Code Enforcement with complaints filed. There are no laws/codes for feral cats in the T/O Clay, however there are Codes for Land Use regarding pets. For residential (majority of property in Bayberry) "No property or dwelling shall contain more than three adult dogs and three adult cats ("adult" is a dog or cat over six months in age)." Article IV §230-20 A3(a) Clay Code.

Please remember when raking leaves to the front of your property to keep them on the edge of the lawn and not in the streets. If there is a street grate near your property please keep an eye on them and keep them clear of debris. Thanks!

## Brush Collection

The Town of Clay Brush Collection began on March 17 and will continue every Tuesday until December 8. Brush includes leaves, grass clippings, shrub cuttings, small branches and twigs, and must be placed in rigid plastic or metal containers. Biodegradable lawn bags are acceptable, if kept dry and intact. Place all containers outside of road pavement and gutters so as not to obstruct traffic or block drainage.
