SAFETY TIPS

It can not be stressed enough to remember to lock your vehicles and homes. Last month, multiple vehicles were stolen in the Towns of Clay and Salina. One of the thieves was apprehended in a garage off of Bayberry Circle and entered through an unlocked garage door. All the vehicles stolen were unlocked with the keys in them, or garage door openers which allowed the thieves to gain access into the homes to find keys to steal the vehicles. There were reports that other vehicles had been rifled through and personal items stolen. The NYS Troopers, Onondaga County Sheriff's Department and Liverpool Police Department worked together, capturing these unwanted individuals and we thank you for keeping the streets of Bayberry safe.

If you witness someone who is going through yours or a neighbor's vehicle, trying to enter a home or stealing packages, call 911 immediately and report it. Even if no one is caught, at least there is an electronic trail of the areas being hit. This will not be tolerated in Bayberry. There are Neighborhood Watch signs all throughout Bayberry, remember WE are all the Neighborhood Watch.

A tip from the Sheriff's Department is to hit the lock button on your key fob after you brush your teeth before going to bed. If you have a surveillance camera on your home and capture someone going into your vehicle, please share it on the NextDoor Bayberry App, Bayberry Facebook, Instagram and Twitter accounts.

Brush Collection

The Town of Clay Brush Collection began on March 17 and will continue every Tuesday until December 8. Brush includes leaves, grass clippings, shrub cuttings, small branches and twigs, and must be placed in rigid plastic or metal containers. Biodegradable lawn bags are acceptable, if kept dry and intact. Place all containers outside of road pavement and gutters so as not to obstruct traffic or block drainiage.
