
No major news on the White Pine Commerce Park and relative land acquisitions.

BRUSH COLLECTION

The Town of Clay Brush Collection is every Tuesday until December. Brush includes leaves, grass clippings, shrub cuttings, small branches and twigs, and must be placed in rigid plastic or metal containers. Biodegradable lawn bags are acceptable, if kept dry and intact. Place all containers outside of road pavement and gutters so as not to obstruct traffic or block drainiage.
