TOWN AFFAIRS

Reminder from the town: be sure to cover garbage cans, so animals and birds cannot get into them.

Town web site Planning Board agenda shows another storage unit site proposed near Bull and Bear on Route 57.

KFC restaurant zoning was approved (going into site of old Bruegger's Bagels on Route 57).

Onondaga County considering use of eminent domain for the White Pine Commerce Park and relative land acquisitions. Site needs 100 additional acres of land.

Hinerwadel's zone change request was denied. One point for the denial was potential traffic issues on Taft Road.

"Clay Marketplace" at Route 31 and Henry Clay Boulevard has completed its environmental site plan review. The site would have 96 rental units within three-story apartment complexes. The site would also have 30,000 square feet of retail, dining, etc. space.

LIVERPOOL CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT NEWS

Residents are encouraged to read the School Bell publication mailed by LCSD. The School Bell has content regarding events, holidays, COVID guidelines, etc.

National Grid awarded a grant of \$14,371 for LCSD to change lighting in the Transportation Facility to LEDs.

Residents with children in the district schools are encouraged to sign-up for ParentSquare, which LCSD is using for teachers and staff to communicate with guardians/parents (see <https://www.liverpool.k12.ny.us/departments/communications/parentsquare>).

The USDA has continued to provide funds, so all students in the Liverpool School District will have free breakfast and lunch. A la carte items are charged separately.

BRUSH COLLECTION

The Town of Clay Brush Collection is every Tuesday until December. Brush includes leaves, grass clippings, shrub cuttings, small branches and twigs, and must be placed in rigid plastic or metal containers. Biodegradable lawn bags are acceptable, if kept dry and intact. Place all containers outside of road pavement and gutters so as not to obstruct traffic or block drainage. Plastic bags are not acceptable either inside or outside of any containers. For more information, visit: www.townofclay.org

LEAF COLLECTION AND STORM DRAINS

Just a friendly reminder to make sure you collect your raked leaves on the edge of your lawn as required by the Town of Clay and not on the road. Leaves in the road restrict driving and walking space. If you live near a storm drain, and are able to do so, please try to keep leaves and debris from building up around the drains so water can run off properly.

When burning anything in your backyard, please use caution with respect to any smoke odors for neighbors around you.
