SCHOOL AFFAIRS

The new fine arts wing is open. This was renovated as part of the 2016 and 2018 Phase 3 project approved by voters.

The budget hearing to be held on May 5 has had a time change. It will now begin at 6 PM at the district office.

TOWN AFFAIRS

May 16, 2022 Town of Clay Board meeting (7:30 pm) - residents are invited to a public hearing regarding the following two agenda items: A proposed 11% water rate increase and The Town of Clay Board is seeking input regarding the use of Onondaga County Community Development funds for 2023.

Town of Clay offices will be closed on Friday May 27 and Monday May 30, 2022.

An electronics supply company, JMA Wireless, expanding on Henry Clay Boulevard (also has Syracuse location).

Check Town of Clay website for COVID-19 testing kit information; the town has kits available from time to time.

The Highway Department has begun paving projects. Please drive carefully around work crews.

Drainage/flooding (non-sewer) issues can be directed to the Highway Department.

The proposed Clay Marketplace, a mix of apartment complexes, retail, etc. at the corner of Route 31 and Henry Clay Boulevard has been progressing, most recently having a proposed zoning change from RC-1 to PDD.

There have recently been some pickup delays due to staff shortages. Residents are advised to be patient and leave brush by the road; it will be picked up as quickly as possible.


