



SCHOOL AFFAIRS

Tyler Drive - Tyler Drive is a mobile data GPS terminal that the Liverpool School district has installed on all school buses. It allows the district and parents to access data on when students board buses, when they exit the bus, the ETA for when a bus is scheduled to arrive at a stop, and more. Students will have a card to scan, when they enter/exit the bus. Parents can download the Traversa 360 app, which allows them to track bus arrival at stops. There is more information on the district website.

TOWN AFFAIRS

Town of Clay budget hearings are upcoming. The following are set for hearings on November 9, 2022: Special Districts (7:35pm), Fire Protection (7:38pm), Uniform Water (7:41pm), and Preliminary Town (7:44pm).

Micron plant coming to the White Pine Commerce Park on Route 31. This will be a major development along the Route 31 corridor.

November 9 - Upcoming public hearing regarding Delta Sonic on Route 31.

Check Town of Clay website for COVID-19 testing kit information; the town has kits available from time to time.

The proposed Clay Marketplace, a mix of apartment complexes, retail, etc. at the corner of Route 31 and Henry Clay Boulevard has been progressing, most recently having a proposed zoning change from RC-1 to PDD.

VETERANS AFFAIRS

VA Health Connect provides 24/7 Virtual Health Care Services by calling a single toll-free number, 1-800-877-6976, to connect Veterans to dedicated and aligned clinical and administrative staff 24/7.

Health Connect is VA's new virtual service that makes it easier to get "The Right Care, Right Now."

Calling 1-800-877-6976 VA Health Connect seamlessly connects Veterans to the quality health care services they need and expect to achieve their desired health goals and outcomes.

Here are just some of the options available through VA Health Connect:

- Talk to a provider
- Ask questions about and/or refill medications
- Address mental health concerns
- Receive lab test results
- Schedule, verify, or reschedule Primary Care appointments

What to expect when calling: A VA provider will review medical records, give advice and treatment options, and follow up with your health care team.

A cell phone, tablet, or computer with a speaker and microphone is required to meet virtually with a VA provider. Call the VA Video Connect Help Desk at 866-651-3180 for technical assistance.

NOTE: VA Health Connect is not a substitute for an emergency department. Veterans with medical or mental health emergencies should call 911 or the Veterans Crisis Line or go to the nearest emergency department.

BRUSH PICK-UP

Residents are reminded to keep and brush/lawn debris out of roadways. Please see the website https://www.townofclay.org/information/brush-district-collection for more information. There have recently been some pickup delays due to staff shortages. Residents are advised to be patient and leave brush by the road; it will be picked up as quickly as possible.

TOWN OF CLAY WINTER STREET PARKING BAN

No on-street parking in the Town of Clay from November 1, 2022 through April 1, 2023. This allows plows to keep the roads clear of snow.



ROAD SAFETY

Cold weather is quickly approaching. Check that vehicles are ready. Change tires. Have an emergency kit in your vehicle. Good items to have in a kit include extra water, a blanket, reflective signals, sand/cat litter to assist with traction, a small shovel, etc.

CURBSIDE RECYCLING



- Do not bag recycling. Place items in bin loose
- No textiles/clothes,* footwear, etc. donate if wearable.
- No needles/syringes,* film plastics,* food waste* or toxic items.*
- Avoid "wish-cycling" when in doubt, throw it out.
- Plastics: Ignore the numbers; use shape to decide recyclability: bottle, jar, jug or dairy tub = recycle.
- Paper: Empty and flatten boxes. Remove packing or film plastics in or around boxes.
- Containers: Must be empty and rinsed. Labels are okay.
- ✓ Lids and caps: Reattach.

WHAT HAPPENS TO TRASH IN ONONDAGA COUNTY?



Trash is turned into electricity at the Waste-to-Energy Facility in Jamesville; it does not go to a landfill.

Each year this reduces greenhouse gas emissions equivalent to taking more than 60,000 vehicles off the road, makes enough energy to power 30,000 homes and recovers all metal in the trash, which is enough to build more than 10,000 cars!
