Residents are responsible for the disposal of any debris removed from their homes whether its furniture, carpeting, flooring, building materials and appliances, just to name a few.

Yardwaste is picked up by the Town of Clay, check out the town's website, townofclay.org, for the dates and rules.

Instead of piling up your debris in front and around your home, get a dumpster or hire a company to remove it before it becomes an eyesore! We have a great sponsor, Bin There Dump That, who can take care of your dumpster needs, 315-750-4150.

On crime

We all love summer breeze, but not intruders! Please remember to keep your cars, doors and windows locked at night before going to bed or when away during the day.

On walkers/runners

Drive slowly and watch out for walkers/runners and children playing when driving through the neighborhood streets. Walkers and runners: Make sure you're walking against traffic;

On solicitors

All solicitors have a background check prior to being issued a permit. Additionally, each individual is issued a permit to carry with them when going door-to-door. The permit is a full page document on 8 ½" x 11" blue paper with a raised seal. There will be a brief description of the business, the date the permit was issued as well when the permit will expire, and the signature of

a deputy town clerk (Gloria Wetmore or Krissy Alpuerto). Clark said all residents have the right to see the permit. If the individual is not carrying one, she advises you to call the Sheriff's non-emergency phone number, 425-2111.

On each other

Keep an eye out for your neighbors. Introduce yourself if you don't already know each other. Check in on your elderly neighbors, especially if they live alone.

“We have many lasting friendships from our early life in Bayberry. We would ride our bikes everywhere and knew everyone along the way. We could walk to school with our friends.”

“During the summer there was lots to do—swimming and parties at the Bayberry pool and of course, there was the movie theater in the plaza. We had many street picnics on Blueberry Road. It was at our house because we could help set up and take down with our parents.”

“Our mom shopped at the bread store in the plaza. She made lunches every day for the five of us. That’s a lot of bread.”

“Bayberry was special in so many ways. We had our own school, churches and our own shopping center. Remember the Tri-R Drugstore for school supplies.”

“When our family gets together, we always say we wish our children could grow up ‘with a Bayberry community in their lives.’”
