2017 BCA Scholarship application now available

Each spring, the BCA gives back to the community by awarding two scholarships to graduating high school students who reside in Bayberry. Along with gracious donations from residents, Edge FCU has contributed to this award (which is now the Bayberry Community Association/Edge FCU Scholarship) allowing us to grant two scholarships to deserving students in the amount of \$500 each.

Eligibility

All graduating high school students who reside in the Bayberry community are eligible to apply for a scholarship presented by the Bayberry Community Association and Edge FCU. The appli-

cation must meet ALL of the following criteria:

- The applicant must be a senior at the time of application.
- The applicant will attend an accredited institution of higher learning in the fall of 2017.
- The parent or guardian must reside in the Bayberry Community and be a dues-paying member of the Bayberry Community Association for the current year 2016-2017.
- Dues must be paid by 12/31/16.
- The applicant must have participated in at least one community service project or have been a member of a volunteer organization during his/her junior or senior year.
- Application must be received by 4/15/17.

Please remember to license your dogs. Licensing your dog in New York state is the law. The cost for an unspayed/unneutered dog in the town of Clay is \$15 per year. Spayed/neutered dog is \$5 per year. If yourunlicensed dog is picked up, it could cost you \$160 to redeem your dog. In addition, you may also be fined for unlicensed dog and/or dog-at-large. However, the greatest concern is the possibility of your pet being hit by a car on one of the busy roads. Please care for your furry family member. Bayberry Community 60th Anniversary Remembering the Early Years, Part 5

This season the NEWS will share letters from our first residents that we received for the 1996 and 2006 anniversary celebrations.

'That development will never last'

When we first saw the model homes in Bayberry, we knew that these were the kind of houses young people dream of. So, we purchased our first home here, a ranch romantically named the "Brentwood," at 9 Elderberry Lane. We moved in on my birthday, March 27, 1959, complete with new baby and new car.

For weeks, we came out to Liverpool every weekend and walked down Buckley Road—now Blueberry Road ... a dirt road at the time—and watched the workers unload the tractor trailer carrying our home, and dump pieces of our house in the front yard.

There was mud everywhere ... huge piles of it in the front and back and little kids in the neighborhood were constantly getting stuck in the stuff.

But, soon the house came together and we moved in. We could sit in our living room in front of the big picture window and watch bulldozers leveling the yards.

Shopping for groceries meant a trek into the village since we had no stores in Bayberry as yet.

Old timers in the village used to tell me (a native of Liverpool) that "that development will never last." Well, we know now how Bayberry has developed into the wonderful community it is.

After eight years of living on Elderberry Lane, we moved into our present house at 204 Blackerry Road. As the kids grew, it seemed that a larger house was necessary.

Eventually the churches were built, the United Church of Christ convened in home at first ... and later became Christ the King Church.

All in all, it has been a great place to raise children and make friends. It certainly seems we like it; we're still here after 39 years.
