### AnJel's Fund: Enjoy life through the pain

Bayberry resident Karianne Crowell founded the not-for-profit AnJel's Fund after her sister Jeanelle Cross died. Jeanelle was 31 years old when she was diagnosed with Stage 4 Triple Negative Invasive Ductal Carcinoma (breast cancer). She fought for 18 months before she lost her battle on Sept. 15, 2012. Her family was determined that something good come from their tragic loss.

"We began AnJel's Fund to help young women who are fighting breast cancer at Upstate. We offer funds to help pamper these women. We will purchase items such as a Coach purse, tickets for time at a spa, tickets to do things with family (ie. zoo, movies, amusement parks), and there are many other options. Our goal is to help women enjoy life through the pain," Karianne said.

AnJel's Fund was named after Jeanelle, whose nickname her entire life was Jel. "We now refer to her as our angel," Karianne said. "We replaced the G with a J to come up with AnJel."

AnJel's Fund is a non-profit organization through the Foundation for Upstate and is solely responsible for raising funds and making any decisions for its organization. 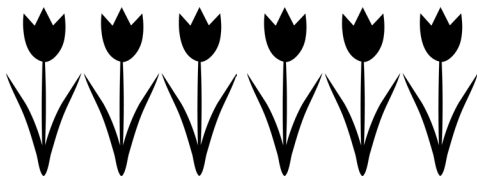

## Budget passes

Liverpool Central School District's proposed budget of \$153,389,263 (2.96 percent) was approved by voters (1,020 yes/ 331 no) on May 16. The tax levy will increase 2.45 percent. Five candidates vied for three 3-year term seats on the school board. Those elected were James Root (864) Stacey O'Neill Balduf (850), and Kevin Van Ness (688).
