# Leaves, storm drains & garbage

Just a friendly Fall reminder to make sure you collect your raked leaves on the edge of your lawn that is required by the Town of Clay and not on the road. Leaves in the road restrict driving and walking space.

If you live near a storm drain, and are able to do so, please try to keep leaves and debris from building up around the drains so water can run off properly. If you have

**Pumpkin Gingerbread** 

3 1/2 cups all purpose flour

Sift together:

1 1/2 tsp salt

2 tsp ginger

1 tsp nutmeg

1 tsp cloves 1 tsp allspice

1 tsp cinnamon

Cream together:

3 cups sugar

1 cup salad oil

2/3 cup water

1 1lb can of pumpkin

4 eggs

2 tsp baking soda

1/2 tsp baking powder

items that were not collected during garbage pickup, please bring them back to vour home until the next pickup day. You can also contact Butler at 315-342-0832 for the cost to make a special pickup. Finally, please note that Centro recently removed a sign on Bayberry Circle and Blackberry Road. However, they left the post stub in the ground. Please be careful and aware of it until it is removed.

## Leaf pickup (from the town of Clay website)

The Town of Clay Highway Department will continue to pick up the leaves through the months of November and December, weather permitting. If leaves are too wet from the snow or rain, the leaf vacuum cannot retrieve them, and if snow accumulates on the leaves, they will not be visible for the crews and may be missed. If leaves are bagged in biodegradable bags, there is less chance of loose leaves being left at curbside. The town understands that purchasing these

types of bags is an added expense; therefore, burlap bags are available "first come, first serve" to residents at no additional cost. You may pick up burlap bags in the white shed located in the parking lot next to the highway department, 4483 Route 31. Quantity is limited. If no bags are available, the town will replenish as soon as the supplier provides them. Please have your leaves out in time for pick up so that the highway crews can continue with their scheduled work as planned.

#### **Spiced Sweet Potatoes**

3 lbs sweet potatoes, peeled and cut into bite sized wedges

- 1/2 cup honey
- 1/2 stick unsalted butter (1/4 cup)
- 3-4 bay leaves
- 1/2 teaspoon allspice
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper

Preheat oven to 450F. Spread prepared potatoes on a jelly roll pan.

Mix the last 6 ingredients in a small sauce pan over medium heat. When mixed together and warmed through (almost boiling), poor over the potatoes.

Bake for 20 minutes, flipping halfway.
