LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK

Over the past several months, the Bayberry Community Association has solicited feedback from our residents and neighbors regarding their experiences and the ongoing impact of the COVID-19 pandemic. The most common response focused on safety within the community, particularly as it pertains to pedestrians and vehicle traffic.

The concerns surrounding drivers speeding or being distracted in Bayberry have prompted many discussions over time, and especially over the past year. We have been in constant contact with the Town of Clay and the Onondaga County Sheriff's Department regarding these concerns. Although speed bumps are not feasible in our area due to snow plow traffic, increased speed enforcement has been discussed. We are also exploring opportunities to add additional crosswalks or lighted signs throughout Bayberry.

As we know, many of our neighbors are staying active by walking or running outdoors. The accumulation of snow has exacerbated this issue by reducing the ability of pedestrians to easily traverse alongside the roadway, ultimately pushing them closer to the flow of traffic. WINTER REMINDERS

If there is a sewer grate near your home, please take a look to ensure that it is not covered with any leaves or debris before winter finally arrives. Standing water will now become dangerous ice.

Please do not throw, blow or plow snow onto the streets.

Moyers Corners Fire Department asks that if you live near a fire hydrant, please clear a three foot radius around them. We certainly don't want them to go into service, but when they do, seconds are crucial.



SCHOOL AFFAIRS

Kindergarten Registration - Children born on or before December 1, 2016 are eligible to attend kindergarten in September. Additional information and all forms can be found on the Liverpool Central School District's website.

Early Pre-K for 4 year olds will again be offered through the Liverpool School District. To apply for your child to be accepted into the program, an EPK notice of interest form must be completed. The forms are now available online and are due March 14, 2021. If there are still openings at that time, the process will resume.

New Health forms are required by NYS for student physicals. There is a link on the LCSD website to access the forms to bring to your health care provider.

The new athletic wing at the high school has been completed.
