BAYBERRY AREA PAVING UPDATES

The following streets, roads, etc. are planned for 2022 – Easton, Forrester, Berrywood, Quail, Oriole, Gull, and Finch. The following are planned for 2023 – Bayberry Circle loops (to be finished), Cardinal, Dove, Ibis, and Jennings. In the near future, the following are planned – Blackberry Road and Bayberry Circle.

SCHOOL AFFAIRS

The new superintendent, Daniel Henner, will start July 1, 2022.

The district budget and propositions were passed by district voters. Elected to three-year terms to the Board of Education were Nick Blaney, Hayley Downs, and Kimberly Martin. Elected to a one-year term was Craig Dailey.

The Nate Perry School on Buckley Road will close in June. The building has been sold to Terra Science and Education, Inc., for \$3.9 million. It will become the Syracuse Academy of Science and Citizenship Charter School.

2022-2023 school year scheduled to begin September 8, 2022.



TOWN AFFAIRS

Chick-fil-A seeking adjustments to zoning for property at Brewerton Road and East Taft Road. The adjustments are mostly to allow for more parking and the implementation of a drive-through lane.

Check Town of Clay website for COVID-19 testing kit information; the town has kits available from time to time.

The Highway Department has begun paving projects. Please drive carefully around work crews.

Highway Department, per the Town of Clay website, should fix lawn damage from snow plows starting in June.

Drainage/flooding (non-sewer) issues can be directed to the Highway Department.

The proposed Clay Marketplace, a mix of apartment complexes, retail, etc. at the corner of Route 31 and Henry Clay Boulevard has been progressing, most recently having a proposed zoning change from RC-1 to PDD.

The Canine Program at Clear Path for Veterans is for those who are seeking an alternative and integrative form of healing and reintegration into civilian culture. Throughout a 6 to 12 month journey, veterans diagnosed with post-traumatic stress (PTS), traumatic brain injury (TBI), and/or experienced military sexual trauma (MST) will connect with their canine companions on a mutually beneficial level. This evidence-based training has proven successful in mitigating symptoms related to PTS and increasing self-compassion.
