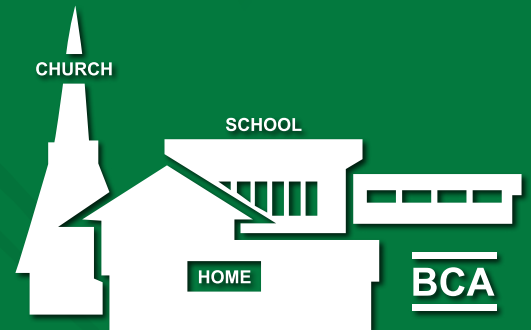

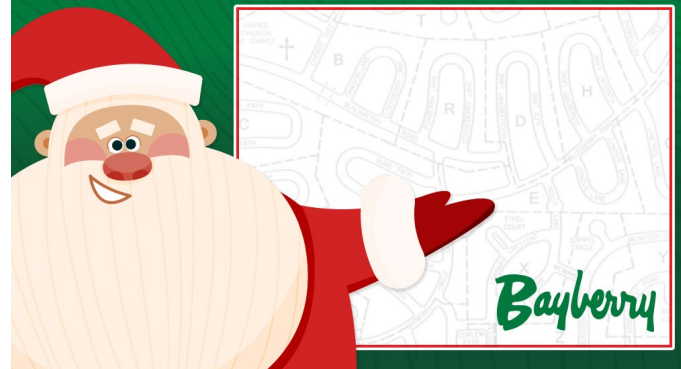
SANTA'S DRIVE THROUGH

NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH TIPS — NOVEMBER

SECURE YOUR HOME: Ensure all doors and windows have secondary locks. Do not hide spare keys in obvious places like under doormats or in planters.

IMPROVE VISIBILITY: Make sure outdoor lights are working and turned on after dark, or use motion-sensor lights. Trim trees and shrubs so they do not provide hiding spots for potential criminals.

SECURE GIFTS: Place all holiday gifts where they cannot be seen from the outside through windows.

Protect valuables: Store valuable items like jewelry, coin collections, or stock bonds in a safe deposit box.

MAIL WISELY: Mail cards, checks, or gift certificates from a Post Office or a blue U.S. Postal Service collection box, not from your home mailbox.
