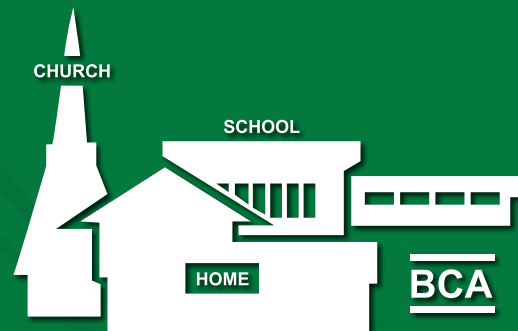

ROAD SAFETY

Due to continuing cold weather, check that vehicles are ready, including batteries. This is a good time to check and change tires if needed. Have an emergency kit in your vehicle. Good items to have in a kit include extra water, a blanket, reflective signals, sand/cat litter to assist with traction, a small shovel, etc.

SCHOOL AFFAIRS

The district's strategic plan is being updated, focusing on three to four areas, which will be presented to the school board. The New York State Education Department posted a digital equity survey, which is open until February 13. There is a resolution proposed for partial property tax exemptions for emergency services/volunteer fire fighters; it may not be necessary due to tax code changes. Online public comment period open on LCSD web site. Pre-K registration via lottery is open until February 16.

TOWN OF CLAY WINTER STREET PARKING BAN

2026 OFFICE ELECTIONS

MARCH

Nominees shall be called for at the March Board of Directors meeting and a second call for nominees shall be published via Association Media including the March newsletter.

APRIL

Nominees for all officer positions will be announced by the Election Committee and any additional nominations accepted from the floor at the April Board of Directors Meeting. Nominees will be given the opportunity to introduce themselves and submit a short introduction for publication in Association Media. Two ballots listing the finalized slate of candidates shall be published in the April Newsletter. Members shall be advised of their option to mail in their ballot to the Association P.O. Box or submit it at the May meeting via designee rather than attending in person. The list of candidates shall also be publicized via Association media.

MAY

Balloting: All ballots must be submitted prior to the close of voting at the May meeting. Blank ballots shall be available at the meeting. The president shall announce the close of voting whereupon no further ballots will be accepted. All ballots will be tallied by the members of the Election Committee. The Secretary shall announce the results of the balloting once the tally is complete. The newly elected Officers shall assume their duties on July 1st.

BCA SCHOLARSHIP

The BCA scholarship, awarded annually to a volunteer-oriented high school senior who lives in the association neighborhoods, is another way the BCA gives back to the community. For a high school senior going on to college or trade school this scholarship is a great way to help out. This scholarship is funded

THE IMPORTANCE OF OUR \$10 ANNUAL DUES

The purpose of the BCA is to facilitate communication and a sense of community within the neighborhood; to keep residents informed; to advocate for our interests with local government; to organize community events and activities; and to keep the community a safe, friendly and well-maintained place to live.
