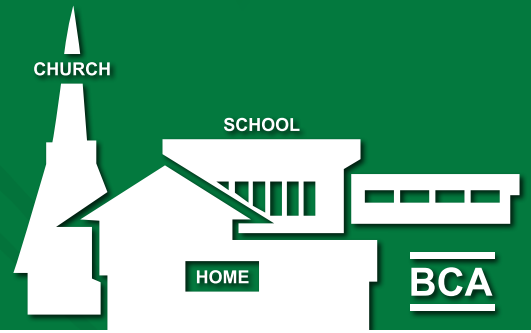

ROAD SAFETY

With improving weather, crews may be working on potholes, cleaning roadways, etc. Please pay extra attention for those working.
