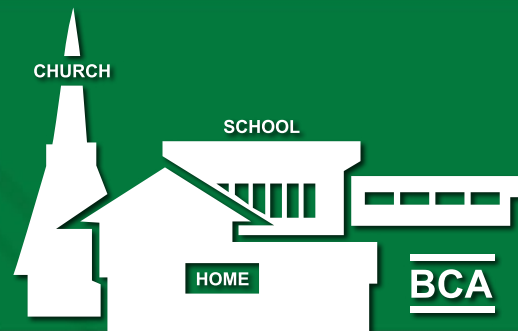

Hello neighbors,

Tom and I wanted to let everyone know that we will no longer be planting and caring for the front entrance to Bayberry.

It's been such a rewarding experience, and we've truly enjoyed doing it over the years.

Unfortunately, it became more difficult each season after we lost our water source. We ended up hauling buckets of water down every evening, and it eventually became more than we could keep up with.

This year, we decided not to plant flowers because of how challenging it had become. Instead, we laid landscape fabric and added a nice, thick layer of mulch to help keep the entrance looking neat. However, weeds have started popping up around the edges of the fabric.

We're hoping that someone in the neighborhood might be willing to lend a hand by pulling some of the weeds. We're officially passing the torch, so to speak, and will no longer be maintaining the front entrance.

Thank you to everyone who has supported and appreciated our efforts over the years. We hope someone will be inspired to continue caring for this beautiful part of our neighborhood.

THE IMPORTANCE OF OUR \$10 ANNUAL DUES
