Dear Property Owner:

This letter is to update you regarding a New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) road resurfacing project in your area to be performed during the 2016 construction season. If your property is not owner-occupied, we ask that you also please share this letter with the tenant(s) who occupy your property.

NYSDOT will hold an open house meeting on Wednesday, October 7, 2015, regarding this project. The open house will take place from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. in the Clay Town Hall, located at 4401 State Route 31, in Clay.

At the meeting, preliminary drawings for the upcoming project will be available for review and representatives from NYSDOT will be present to answer questions. No formal presentation is planned.

Preliminary plans call for milling and resurfacing Route 31 from the Belgium Bridge, west of Gaskin Road, to the westerly limit of the recent highway widening project at Henry Clay Blvd. A limited area of Soule Road between Route 31 and the Route 481 southbound entrance ramp will also be included in the project. In addition, minor drainage, sidewalk, traffic signal and safety improvements will take place at various locations within the project area. Traffic will be maintained on-site during construction, with flaggers when necessary. Nighttime construction will be utilized to minimize the impact to the traveling public. Access to driveways will be maintained at all times during construction. Work is expected to take place during the 2016 construction season.


This open house is part of the continuing effort by the Department to encourage public participation in the development of transportation projects.
